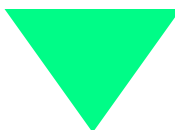

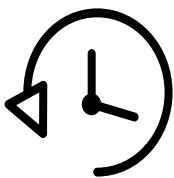

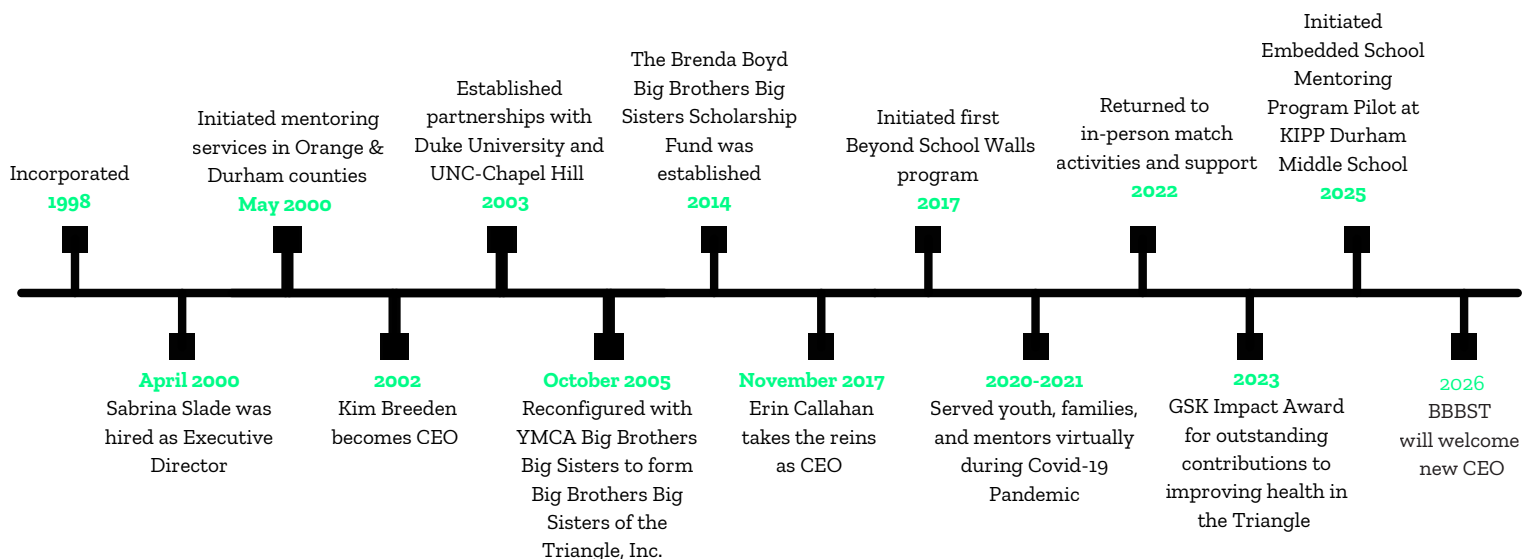

History



Big Brothers Big Sisters of Orange and Durham Counties was incorporated in 1998, by the efforts of community volunteers in affiliation with Big Brothers Big Sisters of America. Founding board members included Jodie Bennett, Will Bernard, Henry "Buck" Branson, Rick Brown, JoAnn Comis, Herbert Davis, Henry Essey, Phillip Graham, Nelson Kerr, Julie King, Darryl Mitchell and Charles Tuck. This group of concerned community members wanted to make a difference in the lives of children, from single-parent homes, within the Durham & Orange County areas. Initial funding was provided through foundations (Z Smith Reynolds and the Durham Merchants Association), local businesses (Bank of America, Ericsson, Novartis, and GTE) and community support.
